By signing below, you agree to the following statements:

1. The Charity is devoted exclusively to exempt purposes set forth in section 501(c)(3) of the US Internal Revenue Code. Relevant exempt purposes are charitable, religious, educational, scientific, literary, fostering national or international amateur sports competition, and preventing cruelty to children or animals. The term *charitable* is used in its generally accepted legal sense and includes relief of the poor, the distressed, or the underprivileged; advancement of religion; advancement of education or science; erecting or maintaining public buildings, monuments, or works; lessening the burdens of government; lessening neighborhood tensions; eliminating prejudice and discrimination; defending human and civil rights secured by law; and combating community deterioration and juvenile delinquency.
2. The Charity is not organized or operated for the benefit of private interests, and no part of the net earnings of the Charity inures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual.
3. The Charity understands and agrees that no goods or services may be exchanged as quid pro quo to any individual or organization for any grants received from American Support for Israel, Inc.
4. The Charity understands and agrees that when donors recommend that funds be allocated to the Charity, American Support for Israel, Inc. will take note of the recommendation. However, American Support for Israel, Inc. shall retain full control of all funds, exercises absolute discretion as to their use, and retains the right to discontinue funding (including the refund of funds already granted but not expended) at any time it

determines that the project goals or standards of performance are not being met, accountability standards are not being satisfied, or in American Support for Israel, Inc.'s sole discretion for any other reason.

If American Support for Israel, Inc. decides not to allocate funds according to a donor's recommendation, it will return the donation in full to the original donor.

5. The Charity agrees to notify American Support for Israel, Inc. immediately if there is a material change in any of our operations of the Charity.
6. The Charity agrees that if it receives funding from American Support for Israel, Inc. in excess \$5,000 in any calendar year, it shall submit, by April 1 of the following year, a report explaining the use of funds. If the Charity receives funding from American Support for Israel, Inc. in excess of \$25,000 in any calendar quarter it shall submit a report, within three months of the quarter's end, explaining the use of funds. The extent and detail of required reports shall be commensurate with the dollar amounts of the grants. The Charity may, and if it receives in excess of \$100,000 from American Support for Israel, Inc. in any calendar year shall, be required to provide line item accounting of expenditures funded by the American Support for Israel, Inc. in sufficient detail to demonstrate that funds are being expended in effective furtherance of the stated charitable purpose.
